The committee discussed the **New York State Refund policy**. This policy was put into place during Covid. The policy was:

If the Meet Director cancels the meet because of their own reasons or choice, they would refund the entire entry fee. If the cancellation is due to a reason which is out of the meet directors control, the following refunds would be:

Meet cancelled more that 2 weeks from the competition date -100% refund

Meet cancelled less that 2 weeks from the competition date -75% refund

If the meet director chooses to not follow the NYS Refund policy, they would not be able to host a qualifying meet for the following 2 competitive seasons.

The committee discussed what had taken place at the last board meeting concerning state championships and outside venues.

Three venues had been paid previously in prior years, but were cancelled due to Covid. They are: The ON Center (CNY), Canisius College (Niagara) and Bill Gray's Ice Complex (Victor's). If the dates work for these venues and all aspects of the meet are the same, then the state championships would be held at these locations this year. Outside venues can change over time due to Covid. For this reason, we are still accepting bids for all of the state meets, including the three state meets mentioned here

***NYS Gymnastics is now accepting bids for the state championships at all levels. The bid form is on the state website. Go to 'forms' and 'host states-outside venue'. This form is for hosting states in an outside facility, but you must also list your 'Plan B' in the event that the outside venue is cancelled. Send these bids to the state chair. The deadline for these bids is November 15th.

Election of officials to state championships-

The membership has voted on the officials for the 2022 State Championships. This vote concluded on Monday, Sept 13th. The results will be given to the state board (coaches on the board only -all judges will recuse themselves from the meeting) and the coaches on the board will use these results to assist them in deciding on the officials for each state meet. The meeting of the state board coaches will be on Sunday, October 17th.

State Qualifier Meets-

If you are having a meet that you would like to request that it be used as a state qualifier, send the request to Larry Goldsmith, lgoldniag@aol.com and send a copy to Barry Coss at barry.coss@gmail.com

The meet will be posted on the website, as a qualifier and the host club will be responsible to pay \$4 head tax per NY gymnast payable to 'NYS Gymnastics'.

Declaration Date: The declaration date is set to allow athletes to "try" to move up to a higher level. As the season progresses, they must commit to a specific level by the declaration date. Whatever level you are at, as of the declaration date, is the level you must compete for the rest of that season. The State Board is moving the date back to February 1, 2022, as it has been in the past.

New Educational requirements from USA Gymnastics-

This season, USA Gymnastics will introduce two new educational courses that certain membership roles will be required to complete as a condition of membership. The courses are: U112: Tough Coaching or Emotional Abuse course and the U113: USA Gymnastics Safe Sport Policy course. Go to USA Gymnastics for further information.
