New York State Committee

The NYS Gymnastics Board met at Regional Congress and have decided to restructure the geographic representation on the board.

What does this mean?

It means that there will be a member of the state board who will be your primary link between clubs within their district and the state board. The goal is to improve communication with your state committee and have a clearly identified representative to distribute information.

Each club will be receiving a letter from their state committee representative identifying the representative and their email for communication. This new system is for coaches, judges and club owners. It is not for parents or gymnasts. All of the representatives are members of your state board currently.

The state board will have a zoom meeting every first Wednesday of the month at 10:00 AM to continue to discuss policies and problems that need to be addressed.

State Meet Bids

If you would like to host a state championship this year, you must fill out the bid form located on the state website and email it to me. Please note that all of our state championships are held in venues and are not held in gymnastics clubs or training facilities. The **deadline date to submit a bid is August 29th.**

The state meet dates and levels for 2027 were tentatively published last year to give clubs an opportunity to secure a venue. I am also attaching the schedule below.
